

## UCF wins competition

A computer-science team of UCF students pointed and clicked their way to a first-place finish last month at the Southeast region's collegiate computer programming competition at the College of Charleston in South Carolina.

It is the 16th-consecutive year UCF has placed no lower than third in the regional contest, which is sponsored by the Association for Computing Machinery, a Washington trade group.

Other UCF teams also placed fourth and eighth out of 58 collegiate teams.
